WATER REPORT – February 7, 2023

Snow-water-content (SWE) at SNOTEL sites is currently above median levels, exceeding last year's basin-wide SWE percentages for this date. Total precipitation (PRECIP) since October 1st is slightly below the median level for the basin above Palisades but is above the median level for other basins.

The reservoir system currently holds approximately 89,000 acre-feet less storage than held in the reservoir system last year on this date. In last month's water report, releases past Milner Dam were incorrectly reported as being zero because of a gaging error that occurred on the date the report was prepared. The discharge passing Milner Dam has held relatively steady at 200 cfs since releases began on December 1st. Releases past Milner Dam are expected to be decreased to zero in mid-February.


