WATER REPORT – March 6, 2023

Snow-water-content (SWE) at SNOTEL sites is currently above median levels, exceeding last year's basin-wide SWE percentages for this date. Total precipitation (PRECIP) since October 1st is slightly below the median level for the basin above Palisades but is above the median level for all other basins. The reservoir system currently holds approximately 77,000 acre-feet less storage than held in the reservoir system last year on this date.


